Things to consider when writing and sharing your testimony:

DO	DON'T
Follow a basic outline	Wing it
Present the Gospel clearly	Use a lot of Christian jargon (saved, born again, converted...)
Mention how your life has changed since following Jesus	Be too wordy
Ask them if they have considered following Jesus	Beat around the bush
	Emphasize how 'bad' I used to be
	Mention church denominations in a derogatory way
	Give the idea that when someone becomes a Christian, everything in life is easy

Jim's Sample Testimony

I first sensed my need for Jesus when...

I was in a terrible car accident when I was 25. I had been drinking and was way over the speed limit when my car spun off the road and flipped over four times. God kept me from dying because there is no reason I should have survived. The car accident helped me see how every area of my life was out of control and that I was going to kill myself if I didn't make some changes. I went to a Christian friend of mine that I respected and he seemed to listen to me really well and he genuinely cared for me. He seemed to have his life in order and so I started asking him questions about his life and his faith and told him that I needed some help. He told me to give my life over to Jesus.

What made me most interested in Jesus was...
